

Action	Cost/resources
Providing TRS (Teacher Relief Scheme) to release teachers from class to collaborate with school leadership team and regional staff in co-planning and data meetings each term and engage in co-teaching in other year levels.	\$15,248
Increasing leadership of all teachers – TRS to release teachers from class to attend Leadership Team meetings to progress targeted areas of our Annual Implementation Plan such as NAPLAN preparation in years 3 and 5	\$15,000
Providing school funding to employ a Band 6 Deputy Principal to maintain a Leadership focus within the school	\$90,000 for semester 1.
